

EYFS Home Learning

Please find attached, learning opportunities that you can do with your child at home. *The day's are a guide, go at your child's pace, go into as much depth and breadth that your child is keen for, you may find that they take the learning in a different direction, just go with it!*

These activities are designed to be short and sharp activities and used in addition to all the activities that you already do with your child e.g. jigsaws, building models, creative actives (loads of ideas on pintrest), sharing stories, listening to music etc. You are welcome to work directly on the packs that we have provided. They are a working document, just tick off and date when you have done things. Although it is organised in days you can do any of the work in any order.

Remember when you do these activities ask questions to get feedback on your child's understanding and at this age you never know which way the learning will go! You will be very much steered by your child and their understanding, interest and questioning.
