

PRACTICAL IDEAS.

<p>CREATE A ROBOT USING EMPTY BOXES AND BOTTLES.</p> <p>Encourage children to see if their robot can include any moveable parts, using mechanisms they may have learnt.</p>	<p>DESIGN A VIDEO GAME. CREATE A STORY BOARD TO DESCRIBE WHAT HAPPENS.</p> <p>Discuss what the objective of the game is and what the main character has to do along the way. What type of game will it be? Will there be different levels?</p>	<p>MAKE A CAKE WITH AN ADULT DESIGN A POSTER TO ADVERTISE YOUR PRODUCT</p> <p>When tasting, discuss ideas for adjectives that can be used. Look at different advertisements and discuss things you like and dislike.</p>
<p>LISTEN TO YOUR FAVOURITE SONGS. IDENTIFY THE INSTRUMENTS YOU CAN HEAR?</p> <p>Encourage children to concentrate on the music and the sounds made by different instruments. Use effective adjectives to describe the sounds. Discuss the tempo/rhythm</p>	<p>GO ON A NUMBER HUNT CREATE CALCULATIONS USING THE NUMBERS YOU HAVE FOUND.</p> <p>Discuss different places to collect numbers. Encourage children to create addition, subtraction, multiplication and division calculations.</p>	<p>FIND OBJECTS TO MAKE ARRAYS. SHOW EACH CALCULATION IN THE 8 TIMES TABLE</p> <p>Discuss how the arrays add a row of 8 each time, so calculations can be answered by repeated addition → $8 + 8 + 8$</p>
<p>EXPLORE THE GARDEN OR PARK. HOW MANY ANIMALS CAN YOU FIND?</p> <p>Discuss with the children why certain animals are better suited to their different micro-habitats. E.g. worms and damp soil, so they don't dry out.</p>	<p>CHOOSE A BOOK TITLE. ACT IT OUT IN FRONT OF YOUR FAMILY. CAN THEY GUESS YOUR BOOK TITLE?</p> <p>With a friend or family members, take it in turns to play. Choose different children's books, and act out without speaking.</p>	<p>DESIGN A MENU.</p> <p>Imagine you had your own restaurant. What would your menu be? Be as imaginative as you like, you may include a starter, main, pudding and a drink.</p>
<p>DESCRIBE AN OBJECT.</p> <p>Can you describe an object without mentioning its name? Could you write a list of clues for someone to guess what the object might be?</p>	<p>DESIGN A PRODUCT.</p> <p>Invent a new gadget make a poster to advertise it. Try to convince people to buy it.</p>	<p>DRAW A PICTURE OF YOUR FAVOURITE ANIMAL. CREATE A FACT FILE TO SHARE WITH A FRIEND.</p> <p>Discuss what different resources could be used depending on what is available, for example: paint, pencils or collage. Discuss where/how to find facts.</p>
<p>DRAW A MAP OF YOUR AREA.</p> <p>Draw a map of an area you know well. Can you add symbols to your map? Don't forget to include a key.</p>	<p>INVESTIGATE WAYS OF MAKING YOUR HEART BEAT FASTER WITHOUT RUNNING.</p> <p>Discuss different movements you could do, such as jumps. Hops etc. Demonstrate paying attention to your heartrate and your breathing.</p>
