This is our homework bingo for the term. I have outlined a number of different homework activities to choose from. Each activity relates to our topic work. The expectation is that one activity will be completed each week. There are more activities here than there are weeks in the term - children are not expected to complete them all (unless they really want to!), this is simply to give them more choice. Where possible, homework will be completed and filed in school and celebrated in class on Thursdays.

Reading and spellings will run alongside this homework.

Find some non-fiction books about dinosaurs at school, home or the library. Write out 5 of the most fascinating facts you can find.	Design your own dinosaur and label it. Write about what it looks like, what it eats and where it lives. Don't forget to give it a name.	Create your own dinosaur landscape picture using paint, paper and fabric.	Choose a dinosaur to describe using interesting describing words.
Using what you know about dinosaurs, can you write your own dinosaur quiz game?	Choose your favourite dinosaur - create a fact page, poster or leaflet about it.	Can you find a dinosaur for each letter of the alphabet?	Make your own dinosaur top trumps cards. You could score it on height, weight, age, killer rating or intelligence.
Write a list of foods that a carnivore dinosaur might eat today. What about a herbivore dinosaur?	Draw and label a dinosaur's body parts (leg, head, tail, horns etc.)	Design a menu for a dinosaur of your choice. Be as imaginative as you like, you may include a starter, main, pudding and drink.	Use cardboard boxes, yogurt pots etc. to make a dinosaur mask. Can you write a set of instructions for how to make your mask?
